

PCO (Public Call Office)


Come, let's have a party tonight at the park in our neighbourhood. I will arrange for pastries, sweets and other things that we like to eat.



Around ten years ago, most neighbourhoods had one or more PCOs (Public Call Offices). Nowadays, these PCOs are seen only in small towns and villages. They offer local, STD and International call facilities. From the PCO, we can make telephone calls to friends or relatives in our city. Such calls are called local calls. When we want to call friends living in other cities, we make STD calls. When we want to talk to people living in other countries, we make ISD calls. Talking to our friends and relatives would have been difficult if we did not have PCO in our neighbourhood. With growing usage of mobile phones, demand of Public pay phones and PCOs declined. In the coming years these mobile phones would completely take over the PCOs.


